ACTIVITY: A Heart of Truth

"I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you." (Psalm 119:11) This heart of truth craft is a reminder of the importance of learning the truths in the Bible.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Pink or red construction paper
- White construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Colored pencils

STEPS:

1. Cut out a large heart from the red or pink paper.
2. Fold the heart in half.
3. Cut out a rectangle small enough to fit inside the heart.
4. Write out the full verse (Psalm 119:11) on the white rectangle.
5. Glue the rectangle inside the folded heart.
6. Decorate the outside of the folded heart.
7. Put this in a place where you will see it every day to remind you to read your Bible.
