ACTIVITY: The Service of a Bee

YOU WILL NEED:

- Toilet paper roll Googly eyes
- Yellow and black paint
- Paint brush
- Googly eye
- Cup of waterWax paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Hole punch

Cleaners

- Black pipe
- vre

STEPS:

- 1. Paint the outside of the toilet paper roll yellow.
- 2. Rinse your brush and paint 3 or 4 black stripes around the roll.
- 3. Add googly eyes.
- 4. Cut out wings from the wax paper and glue to the back of the toilet paper roll honeybee.
- 5. Punch two holes on the back of the honeybee behind the eyes. Thread a piece of pipe cleaner through the two holes for antennas.
- 6. Glue on the eyes.
