

DAILY READING: ANGELS AND DEMONS

Demons were once angels but chose to turn against God. Demons are evil. God has not left me alone. As a follower of Jesus, I have been given the power of the Holy Spirit. God sends His angels to care for and protect me. Angels are called into action against Satan and demons when I pray. God created the angels. God's army of angels is larger than Satan's army. Angels work with the Holy Spirit (*God's Spirit*) to carry out God's plans. Though God has given the angels power, they are not more powerful than God. There is only One being in all the universe worthy of praise – God. Jesus defeated Satan and his demons by His death on the Cross and His resurrection to life. Satan and the demons will travel the Earth causing great difficulty for followers of Jesus. Jesus is undefeated. He conquered sin and death and has given me power to overcome the enemy. As a follower of Jesus, I am to serve and worship God only.
