

DAILY READING: ATTITUDE

My attitude will be the same as Jesus'. The attitude of Jesus is marked by humility. Humility means I do not think of myself as better than anyone else. I choose humility with the help of the Holy Spirit living in me. I cannot achieve an attitude of humility on my own. I control my attitude with the power of the Holy Spirit no matter what is happening around me. I choose not to be controlled by my feelings or desires. God has a purpose for me today so I will not allow my attitude to be changed by difficulties or others. God showed Himself to the world when He sent Jesus to earth. Now the love of Jesus can be revealed to others when I choose the same attitude of Jesus. I will put others' needs above my own. I will give up my rights and choose an attitude of humility. My attitude will be the same as Jesus'.

Flying Around

When a pilot flies an airplane, one of the most important things they monitor is the attitude of the plane. The attitude of a plane is the orientation (*position*) of the plane. When the plane turns, it has a different attitude than when the plane is flying on a flat line.



ACTIVITY: Attitude Alterations

People take clothes that don't fit to a tailor, someone who alters clothing so it will fit. Jesus wants to alter your attitude to fit rightly – to be like His attitude. Attitudes have an effect on everything in our lives for better or worse. Consider your appearance when you have a good attitude and when you have a bad attitude. Draw pictures of each.

STEPS:

1. Paint or draw a picture of how you might look when you have a good attitude.
2. Paint or draw a picture of how you might look when you have a bad attitude.
3. If the way you look changes, how might these attitudes be affecting your friendships, your ability to do well in school, etc? Pray and ask God to give you an attitude like Jesus in everything you do.
