Conversation Starters

- What is the best trip or journey you have been on?
- Talk about a time where someone helped you discover something about yourself.
- What has been the most enjoyable experience you have had with others so far this summer?

- Looking back at your Talk Notes, was there anything you heard in the service that stood out or maybe even confused you?

Discussion Starters from the Weekend Talk

Refer to the Talk Notes and related Bible verses from this Weekend's Talk Notes.

- This week Pastors Cody Kiwaczyk, Jeff Love, and Jason Marsden highlighted One Thing to remember from this Talk: **"Jesus Told Me To Go Make Disciples, So I'm Going."**
- Read Matthew 28:19-20 (p.760*)
- Tell of a time you felt God telling you to go and make a disciple.
- How does it make you feel when Jesus tells you He is "with you always, even to the end of the age?"
- The pastors discussed **Three Actions** to go: Go find the lost, Go grow together, and Go all in.
- Talk about a time when you were lost and someone helped you find your way back.
- How have you grown in your relationship with Jesus through helping someone else grow?
- In what way could you and your group or family grow together this week? Maybe a family outing, a shared meal, a Bible reading plan, or serving your community together.
- What does it mean to you to be "all in"?
- What is one step you could take this week to more fully go all in? How could you do this as a group or a family?

Digging Deeper

- **Read through Luke 15 as a group.**
- What stood out to you most when Jesus was talking about lost things?
- What are some of the differences or similarities in the three parables?
- Talk about some ways in which you most relate to what you read.
- Now read a few of the following verses: Luke 19:1-10; Mark 16:15; Acts 1:8; Romans 10:14-15; John 15:16 and Matthew 4:19-20.
- In reading these verses, how would you describe the process of discipleship to others?
- How have you seen discipleship play out in your life?

- Think through some of the people who have been influential in your life and your spiritual journey. Which of the three points (Go find the lost, Go grow together, and Go all in) most reflects their influence in your life?

Next Step

- **Next Step:**
 - I will go make disciples by finding the lost.
 - I will go make disciples by growing together.
 - I will go make disciples by going all in.
- Which of these steps is the hardest for you and why?
- How have you been prompted by God's Spirit to live this out so far this week?
- What are the ways He is leading you to live it out in the future?

- Pray for yourself and others in your group that this week you would all clearly see what step of the journey you are on and in what ways you can *go and make disciples*. Pray that God would reveal people in our lives in which he wants us to invest in through a relationship.
