

DAILY READING: RESIST TEMPTATION

God is strong and makes me strong. My strength comes from His mighty power and is available to me through His Spirit. The power of God working in me is the same power God the Father used to raise Jesus from the dead; and His power prepares me for every spiritual battle I will face on this earth.

I choose to put on the full armor of God today and every day of my life. I know that by the power of Christ in me I will stand strong. First, I put on the belt of truth; it is the foundation for living a healthy life as a follower of Jesus. He is Truth, His Word is Truth, and my character reveals His Truth in me. When the enemy attacks me with his lies and tries to convince me I am not who God says I am, I will stand on the Truth that comes from faith in Jesus who makes me righteous.

With Jesus' peace as my shoes, I am fully prepared for this day and I will march on regardless of the enemy's efforts to tempt me with fear and worry. Christ's peace guards my heart and mind. Faith is my shield and protection through all things. I believe in and trust His promises. I will rely on God and live in a willingness to obey Him.
