ACTIVITY: Three In One

The Holy Spirit, God, and Jesus are all the same, but they are also different. Are ice, liquid, and clouds all made of the same substance? Try this experiment to see if they are.

YOU WILL NEED:

- A bowl
- Ice
- Water
- Plastic Wrap

STEPS:

1. Place some water in the bowl.
2. Next, add the ice cubes to the bowl.
3. Cover the top of the bowl with plastic wrap and then set it in the sun. After the bowl gets warm in the sun, you will see some water droplets forming on the plastic wrap. (*This could take a while.*)
4. All three forms look different – observe (*write down*) what differences you see.
5. Once the ice is melted, take the plastic wrap off and observe what differences you see now.
