

## DAILY READING: WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

Today I choose to live my life by the Spirit. I will allow the Holy Spirit to make the changes in me He desires so that I may become more like Jesus. He began a lifelong process of change in me the moment I put my faith in Jesus. At that moment, He filled me with His presence. The Holy Spirit has worked a miracle in me; my life is changed.
