Pick a flower

- For this activity, I want you to get with parents / or an adult and head outside
- We are learning about about the Parable of the Sower this week and our One Thing is "I will sink my roots deep!"
- Head outside to where you can find some flowers. Maybe you have some in your backyard or along a path near your house. You could even go to a local store and look at their flowers.
- See if you look at the bottom of the flower and if you are able to, pick the flower.
- Do you see any roots? How long do you think the roots are to grow that flower?
- Flowers look nice when they are picked, but when they are not longer in their roots they will slowly die.
- Remember our One Thing, "I will sink my roots deep"

TALK ABOUT IT

This week we learned about a parable. Remember, a parable is a story that helps us to remember a lesson. Talk about these questions with those around you:

- What does it mean to have the thin layer of soil with rocks underneath?
- How can we change our hearts to be like the good soil?
- What are some ways that our hearts become hard?



PRAY ABOUT IT

Take some time to pray about these different points from this week's lesson:

- Pray that God would change your heart in areas that need it.
- Pray for courage when someone makes fun of you for believing in God.
- Pray that God would reveal himself to others in your life that need Him.
