

HEY, PARENTS!

As a follower of Jesus, your child's next step is baptism. Your child hears the Salvation message every week in class and hears about Baptism several times throughout the year. When we have a Baptism Celebration, we take all of our elementary kids to experience the transformation. If your child asks about baptism, talk through the following with them.

Explain: Baptism is a picture of what Jesus did through His death, burial, and resurrection. He tells us to be baptized, just as He was, to show others that we follow Him. This is symbolized by:

- Joining in Jesus' death (our public statement).
- His burial (us going under the water).
- His resurrection (us coming up out of the water).

Read together Matthew 3:13-17 & Matthew 28:16-20
